FMC Corporation Increases Prices for Persulfates

PHILADELPHIA, August 17, 2009 – FMC Corporation (NYSE:FMC) announced today that effective immediately, or as contracts permit, it will increase its list and off-list prices on ammonium persulfate products by 3 cents per pound, and sodium and potassium persulfate products by 6 cents per pound.

“This increase is necessary to allow continued investment in plant operations and to maintain the high level of production and supply reliability that customers expect from FMC,” said Sanjay Gandhi, persulfates business manager, FMC Peroxygens Division.
