Dear Valued Customer:

Thank you for your interest in the lot numbering system used by FMC for Soda Ash and Sodium Bicarbonate.

Below is the explanation of the lot numbering system used for material packaged at the FMC Green River, Wyoming facility. Material packaged elsewhere may follow a different system.

Each container receives a lot number as it is filled. For bags, regardless of size the following system is used.

Soda Ash:

On Certificates of Analyses, etc.: **0216012100B**, Packaged on January 6, 2001, Second Shift, Grade 100.

On bags: **0216012**, Packaged on January 16, 2001, Second Shift. Since the grade is printed on the bags, it is not repeated in the ink jet printed lot number.

Sodium Bicarbonate:

On Certificates of Analyses, etc.: **01-016-#1**, Packaged on the 16th day of 2001 (January 6, 2001), Grade #1

On bags: **01-016**, Packaged on the 16th day of 2001 (January 16, 2001). Since the grade is printed on the bags, it is not repeated in the ink jet printed lot number.

The container and/or paper work may have a batch number printed on it. This is an internal FMC Corporation number used in production and marketing tracking. There is no customer usable information built into it.
